

POOL SEEDINGS

Starting Fall Season 2015 we have a new seeding system. All teams will be seeded together, there will be no individual pool seeding. The criteria for the seeding will be based on the following:

1. Overall Record starting with the greater number of wins – see below:
 - 3-0-0 beats 2-0-1
 - 2-0-1 beats 2-1-0
 - 2-1-0 beats 1-0-2
 - 1-0-2 beats 1-1-1
 - 1-1-1 beats 1-2-0
 - 1-2-0 beats 0-2-1
 - 0-2-1 beats 0-3-0
2. Point System (as shown below)
3. Least runs allowed
4. Greater Runs differential

POINT SYSTEM FOR 1st 3 GAMES PLAYED:

WIN	=	.3333 points
TIE	=	.1665 points
LOSS	=	.0000 points

4th GAME RULES: When an odd number of teams exist in a pool, one team is required to play a 4th game in order for all teams to get their 3rd of 3 guaranteed games. Most teams like the 4th game. No team will get a 4th game more than 1 time per season unless requested. The 4th game played will not count against nor for the team. If the team chooses not to play the 4th game it will count as a forfeit and replace their 3rd game score.

NOTES:

The new system will not take Head to Head pool games into consideration.

If more two or more teams in the same pool finish with the same record it is highly possible the teams will play against each other again in bracket play.

Tournament ASA does a seeding of each age division on-line. Keep in mind that this ranking is not always correct as it includes all games played and we DO NOT count the 4th game when played by teams. Only the first three games will be used in the seeding.
